#### Question

What is the part number for the Replacement Knob Kit for Bulletin 800T 1-2-3-4 Way Toggle Switches?

Is just the end (tip / plug / cap) of the knob that prys off on Bulletin 800T 1-2-3-4 Way Toggle Switches available to purchase?

#### Answer

The part number for the replacement knob kit for the 1-2-3-4 way toggle switch is part number **40274-533-01**. Please note that repair part number **40274-533-01** can only be used on Series 'T' toggle switches. Toggle switches with earlier series letters than 'T' cannot use this repair part number. Devices with earlier series letters than 'T' will have to be replaced if the knob becomes damaged.

The entire knob is sold as a part #. There is not a separate part# for the end cap that prys off. The end cap that pry's off is included with 40274-533-01.

This replacement part number is the replacement knob kit for the following catalog numbers:

800T-T1A2XEXX, 800T-T1C2XDXX, 800T-T2H3EEXX, 800T-T2F3DDXX, 800T-T3P8EAXX, 800T-T3L8DAXX, 800T-T4T8AAXX, 800T-T1A1XEXX, 800T-T1C1XDXX, 800T-T2H1EEXX, 800T-T2F1DDXX, 800T-T3P1EAXX, 800T-T3L1DAXX, 800T-T4R1AAXX, and other catalog numbers that can be configured.

# BOOT REPLACEMENT KIT INSTRUCTIONS BULLETIN 800T, 2-3-4 WAY SWITCH, SERIES "T"

Tools needed: Small pocket screwdriver

## WARNING: Disconnect power before servicing.

- 1. Pry up cap using screwdriver blade in cap slot. Figure 1.
- Pry out E-Ring from shaft using screwdriver blade and discard. Figure 2.
- 3. Slide off knob.
- 4. Remove boot by pinching edge between thumb and fore-finger and pull off. (For panels thicker than 1/8", removal of mounting ring will facilitate boot replacement. Loosen mounting ring and remove while holding device by the shaft. Hold device by the bushing and proceed with boot installation.)
- Clean debris from boot area, Figure 3. For ease of installation place a small amount of lubricant around the chamfered edge of bushing.
- Install new boot over shaft and seal into grooves of shaft and bushing. Figure 3. Rotate boot to verify uniform engagement.
- 7. Tighten octagonal mounting ring securely (50-60 lb-in.)
- 8. Slide knob over shaft.
- 9. Install new E-Ring.
- 10. Push cap on knob securely, do not hammer.
- Check for secureness of knob and proper operation of switch.


